Send up to 3 images of art for sale along with suggested price: by photo, slide or CD, labeled with name and title of work, with a completed, signed application. Also enclose a self-addressed, stamped, envelope for return of images. **Deadline is April 2.**

Suggested artist donation is 50 percent of the price of the art sold for CHEARS outreach programs. Funds raised will go to support on-going work of CHEARS a non-profit 501(c)(3) dedicated to finding better ways to live sustainably through education, arts, and research within the Chesapeake Watershed Community that we all share.

Notification of acceptance will be by email, or phone (if no email is available). All accepted submissions must be ready to hang and delivered to the New Deal Cafe Saturday, May 5, 10:00am-12:00noon.


